Motus Traffic Ltd is an environmentally conscious organisation, which acknowledges the potential impact of its operations upon the environment. The Company objective is to minimize any such impact by:

Assessing the nature, scale and environmental impacts of its activities, products and services.

Appropriate to the purpose and context of the Motus Traffic Ltd, including the nature, scale and environmental impacts of its activities, products and services.

Continually improve through the development of environmental performance evaluation procedures and associated indicators. Preventing pollution, reducing waste and ensuring that, where ever practicable, measures are implemented to protect and preserve natural habitats, flora and fauna.

Comply with or exceed applicable legal requirements and other requirements to which the Organisation subscribes, which relates to its environmental aspects.

Provide a framework for setting environmental objectives and targets, ensuring they are reviewed.

Includes a commitment to continual improvement to enhance environmental performance at Motus Traffic Ltd.

Considering the effect that our operations may have on local communities.

Seeking to work in partnership with the local community and behaving in a considerate and socially responsible manner.

Ensuring effective and expedient incident control, investigation and reporting in line with the Motus Traffic Ltd Environment Policy Statement.

Management and supervisory personnel must ensure that environmental issues are given adequate consideration in the planning for the day-to-day supervision of all works.

Motus Traffic Ltd will comply fully with the duties placed upon it within the requirements of Statutory Legislation (compliance obligations). Whilst at all times complying with, as a matter of best practice, the requirements and duties set out within Approved Guidance as issued by the Environment Agency and other organisations.

All employees and sub-contractors are expected to co-operate and assist in the implementation of this Policy whilst ensuring that their own works, so far as is reasonable practicable, are carried out without risk to themselves, others or the environment. This includes co-operating with management on all environmentally related matters.

Motus Traffic Ltd will take all practical steps to ensure that potential hazards and risks to the environment are identified and that suitable and effective prevention and control measures are implemented. All employees will be provided with the necessary resources, equipment, information, instruction and training to fulfil the requirements of this Policy.

The Directors have overall responsibility for all environmental matters. The operation of this Environmental Policy and associated procedures will be monitored and reviewed on a regular basis to ensure that they remain current and applicable to the activities of Motus Traffic Ltd. This document will be subject to annual management review by the Board of Directors ensuring it is implemented and maintained, copied to all employees on induction or updated changes and displayed on notice-boards inside Company premises.
